### **SABARAGAMUWA UNIVERSITY OF SRI LANKA (SUSL)**

The Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka (SUSL) calls **online applications** to select candidates to follow the degree programmes of;

- 1. B.Sc. Honours in Sport Sciences & Management (SSM)**
- 2. B.Sc. Honours in Physical Education (PED)**

In order to be eligible for admission to the above mentioned degree programmes, candidates should be qualified for university admission with at least “S” passes for three subjects available in Arts, Commerce, Biological Sciences, Physical Sciences or Technology subject streams at the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2019 (Please refer to the Admission handbook 2019/2020).

Aptitude Test will only be conducted in **English medium**.

Candidates can apply;

- only for the B.Sc. Honours in Sport Sciences and Management (SSM) or
- only for the B.Sc. Honours in Physical Education (PED) or
- both B.Sc. Honours in Physical Education and B.Sc. Honours in Sport Sciences and Management (Both SSM & PED)

Any single candidate can apply for both degree programmes.

If any candidate interest to apply for both degree programmes, he/she must **select “Both SSM & PED”** from the dropdown arrow in relevant cage in online application.

Applicants who wish to sit for the Aptitude Tests at SUSL should submit their applications through online registration **on or before 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020**

4. Original of G.C.E. O/L certificate/s (Issued by the Department of Examinations- Sri Lanka) )\* Original seal must clearly visible
5. Your Photo (Passport Size)
6. National Identity Card Copy (Both Sides)
7. Affidavit in support of changes appeared in the application and the certificates, if any

**Duly filled online application together with all the relevant documents will be accepted only on or before 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020.**

## Aptitude Test for B.Sc. Honours in Sport Sciences & Management

&

## Aptitude Test for B.Sc. Honours in Physical Education

Aptitude Test has three components, a written paper, a practical test and Sports Achievements evaluation.

1. **Written Paper:** There are two separate written papers for SSM & PED courses. Theoretical knowledge related to the field of Sport Sciences and Management and field of Physical Education is tested via a one and a half hour (1½ hrs.) objective test for each aptitude test.
2. **Practical Test:** The candidate should produce a valid medical certificate obtained from a licensed medical practitioner before commencing the practical test (specimen form of the medical certificate can be downloaded from the university web site). Practical test components are:
  - 35m Sprint
  - 5×10 m Shuttle run
  - 1000 m Aerobic run
  - Standing Broad Jump
  - Push Ups (Nature of the Push Ups test is same for both male and female candidates)
  - Sit & Reach Test
3. **Sports Achievement and proofing of given information:** Proofing of the given information on the online application would be obtain on the practical test date. All candidates are required to bring the originals of A/L 2019 certificate, O/L certificate/s, Original Paying Voucher, Bank of Ceylon Paying Receipt (Green colour), and if any affidavit in support of changes appeared in the application and the certificates **with a set of photocopies**.

The candidate's sports achievements in International, National, Provincial and District level would be evaluated on the practical test date. Candidates should bring the **Original certificates** of the highest sports achievement obtained within the past five years (2015–2019), with **a set of**

**photocopies** when attending the aptitude test. All the photocopies of the sports certificates should be certified by the Principal of the School/Divisional Education Director/Provincial Education Director or the Sports Director or All island justice of peace

In case, of any of the particulars is found incorrect/false given in the online application, Please note that the University (SUSL) has the sole authority to reject the candidates' eligibility for the aptitude test.
